

FTO Club of Australia



Members and attendees of the FTO Club Australia agree to the following code of conduct when participating in an event held by the FTO Australia club or its members:

1. I will observe and adhere to all applicable road rules and regulations at all times including:
 - 1.1 to and from each approved club-sanctioned cruise destination; and
 - 1.2 before and after each club sanctioned event,and I acknowledge that FTO Australia, its officers, members or associates can not be held responsible for any traffic infringements or offences committed by the driver or occupants of a motor vehicle.
2. I will not speed, perform tyre burnout's or engage in any reckless driving or other conduct that endangers the safety of any person or risk to property:
 - 2.1 whilst travelling to and from each club sanctioned cruise destination;
 - 2.2 before and after each club sanctioned event
3. I will not cause noise pollution by excessive revving of a cars engine or increasing the volume of a car stereo to a level that may be offensive to the public.
4. I will not hold FTO Australia, or its officers, members or associates (in that capacity) responsible for any:
 - 4.1 damage or loss sustained by a motor vehicle driven by me or by any third party property; or
 - 4.2 physical or emotional injuries sustained by any person,
as a result of the presence of myself or a motor vehicle driven by me at a club sanctioned event or activity.
5. I will not carry out any illegal activities in my capacity as a club member or official including but not limited to:
 - 5.1 the possession of, or dealing/trafficking in, illicit drugs or arms/weapons
 - 5.2 verbal and physical assault of the public or fellow members/attendees
 - 5.3 vandalism and/or destruction of public and/or private property
 - 5.4 talking on a mobile phone whilst driving
 - 5.5 sending SMS text or picture messages on a mobile phone whilst driving (State Specific)
 - 5.6 littering on public grounds/property
 - 5.7 unauthorised distribution of pornographic or illicit material
 - 5.8 unauthorised disposal of environmentally sensitive chemicals
 - 5.9 unauthorised broadcast of copyrighted music or film
6. I acknowledge that all mechanical and visual modifications performed to my car are my sole responsibility and that:
 - 6.1 It is up to me to refer to the relevant transport authorities to ensure that the modifications are safe and conform to legal guidelines; and
 - 6.2 It is my responsibility to ensure that the modification work is carried out by qualified mechanics/engineers, and meets relevant ADR (Australian Design Rules – Motor Vehicles Standards. More information at www.dotars.gov.au);
 - 6.3 It is my responsibility to ensure that modifications carried out on the motor vehicle are supported by relevant engineering certifications.

7. I will not hold FTO Australia, its officers, members or associates responsible for any modifications performed to my vehicle that result in:
 - 7.1 the issue of a defect notice;
 - 7.2 a mechanical failure;
 - 7.3 damage to or loss of the vehicle;
 - 7.4 damage to or loss of 3rd party property;

8. I will not physically or verbally threaten FTO Australia, its officers, members or associates, or members of the general public, and I will, in the event of a dispute with FTO Australia or one of its officers or members:
 - 8.1 consult the club state representative first for further advice or mediation;
 - 8.2 refrain from making statements on public in either news, print or other media without prior notice to and consultation with the state representative; andI further acknowledge that:-
 - 8.3 any physical assaults involving FTO Australia members and/or event attendees and/or a member of the public will be reported to the police and other relevant authorities if applicable; and
 - 8.4 any medical or legal expenses incurred for treatment of physical injuries as a result of physical assaults will not be covered by FTO Australia, its members or associates.

9. I will not hold FTO Australia, its officers, members or associates responsible for any physical damage to a car or loss of property as a result of theft from the car during a club-sanctioned event and I acknowledge that:
 - 9.1 It is the respective owner's or user's responsibility to ensure that there are not valuables left inside the car whilst they are away from it and to ensure the vehicle security system is in operational order and switched on; and
 - 9.2 no costs incurred in respect of insurance claims will be covered by FTO Australia, its officers, members or associates (in that capacity).
